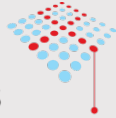

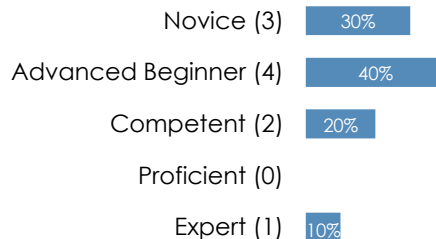

SUMMARY

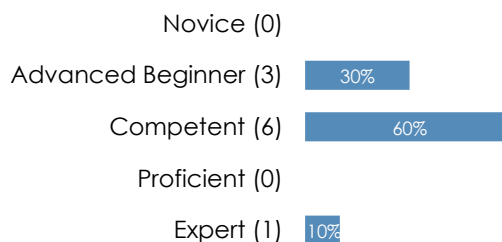
PNP stands for party n' play and has evolved as a subculture for gay, bisexual and other men who have sex with men, involving sexualized drug use, often used to enhance sexual experiences.

Based on the published paper "Scenes as Micro-Cultures: Examining Heterogeneity of HIV Risk Behavior Among Gay, Bisexual, and Other Men Who Have Sex with Men in Toronto, Canada", presenters Gavin Bejaimal (ACT) and Jordan Bond-Gorr (GMSH) discussed PNP harm reduction, and the overall subculture, through the lens of their professional + lived experiences.
